Section A - Herbs - cut specimens

Class 1. Origanum (Oregano)	1 stem
Class 2. Petroselinum (Parsley)	1 stem
Class 3. Rosmarinum officinalis (Rosemary)	1 stem
Class 4. Salvia officinalis (Sage)	1 stem
Class 5. Thymus (Thyme)	3 stems, same variety
Class 6. Any other show worthy cut herb	1 stem

Section B - Bulbs, Rhizomes, Corns, Tubers - cut specimens

Class 7. Dahlia	1 stem
Class 8. Canna	1 stem
Class 9. Tricyrtis (Toad Lily)	1 stem
Class 10. Any other show worthy specimen	1 stem

Section C. - Flowering Container-Grown Plants

Class 11. Pot 6" or smaller
Class 12. Pot >6" to 12"
Class 13. Pot >12" to 18" maximum

Section D. - Foliage Container-Grown Plants

Class 14. Pot 6" or smaller
Class 15. Pot >6" to 12"
Class 16. Pot >12" to 18" maximum

Section E. - Combination Container-Grown Plants

Class 17. Pot 6" or smaller
Class 18. Pot >6" to 12"
Class 19. Pot >12" to 18" maximum

Section F. - Branches of Arboreal Shrubs

Must not exceed 30" in length. Include several nodes and an apical tip.

Class 20. Broadleaf evergreen	1 branch
Class 21. Fruited, berried or coned branch	1 branch
Class 22. Needled evergreen	1 branch

Section G. - Branches of Arboreal Evergreen Trees

Must not exceed 30" in length. Include several nodes and an apical tip.

Class 23. Picea (Spruce)	1 branch
Class 24. Pinus (Pine)	1 branch
Class 25. Tsuga (Hemlock)	1 branch
Class 26. Any other evergreen branch	1 branch

Section H. - Perennials - Cut Specimens

Class 27. Aster	1 spray
Class 28. Chrysanthemum	1 spray
Class 29. Miscanthus (ornamental grass)	1 stalk
Class 30. Ranunculaceae (anemone)	1 stem
Class 31. Rosa (Roses)	1 stem, 2 sets of leaves
Class 32. Any other show worthy cut perennial	1 stem

Section I. - Fruits and Vegetables

Displayed on white plates supplied by the committee

Class 33. Brassica (e.g. broccoli, cauliflower, kale, cabbage)	1 large or 3 medium size or 5 small size, same variety
Class 34. Curcubita maxima (squash e.g. pumpkin, butternut, acorn etc.)	1 specimen with stem attached and trimmed to 1/2" to 1"
Class 35. Leafy Greens (e.g. spinach, chard, etc.)	1 bunch
Class 36. Any other show worthy fruit or vegetable	1 large or 3 medium/small size, same variety

Section J. - Annuals - Cut Specimens

Class 37. Coleus	1 leaf
Class 38. Salvia	1 stem
Class 39. Zinnia	1 stem
Class 40. Any other show worthy cut annual	1 stem

Division III - Botanical Arts

Section C. Botanical Arts Horticulture

Trees and shrubs with recognized fall color interest, majority of leaves attached. Branch not to exceed 30". Must include several nodes and apical tip.

Class 7. Acer (Maple)	1 branch
Class 8. Fagus (Beech)	1 branch
Class 9. Quercus (Oak)	1 branch
Class 10. Any other deciduous branch showing fall color	1 branch
